## INTERNATIONAL FACULTIES



Professor Nikolai J Hopf, MD

Professor Hopf was born on 19 October 1964 in Würzburg/ Germany and went to medical school in Mainz, Munich and Morgantown/ WV/ USA. After passing the German and United States medical examination (USMLE) he trained in Neurosurgery from 1990 to 1996 in Mainz with Prof. Axel Perneczky, including a clinical training with Dr. Kim Manwaring in Phoenix/ AZ/ USA on endoscopic pediatric neurosurgery. He passed his neurosurgical national board examination in 1996 and became associate professor in the department of Neurosurgery at the Johannes-Gutenberg-University in Mainz under the direction of Prof. Axel Perneczky. He was elected Professor and Vice-Chairman from 1999 until 2003. In 2003 he was elected for chairman of the department of Neurosurgery in Stuttgart/ Germany at the Katharinenhospital. Presently, the department consists of 12 neurosurgeons and a residency program for 2 residents per year. The department is internationally known for minimally invasive and endoscopic neurosurgery.

Professor Hopf has served as a tutor in more than 45 national and international hands-on courses on endoscopy and minimally invasive neurosurgery, including courses at the AANS. Currently, he organizes and directs the certified course of the German Society of Neurosurgery (DGNC) on "Cranial Neuroendoscopy". In cooperation with Professor Robert Reisch he directs a series of international courses of the Aesculap Academy on "Basic, Advanced and Applied" neuroendoscopy, including live-surgery events. Professor Hopf is author and co-author of numerous scientific publications in the field of endoscopic and minimally invasive neurosurgery, a frequently invited speaker at national and international meetings and has hosted many international guests in Stuttgart.

Robert Reisch, MD

Professor Reisch was born on 19 October 1971 in Budapest/Hungary. He finished the Semmelweis Medical School in Budapest in 2006 with the highest award „Pro Scientia“-Prize, founded by the President of the Hungary. After one year fellowship in the Anatomical Institute of the Semmelweis Medical School in Budapest, he participated in the neurosurgical training from 1997 to 2003 in the Neurosurgical Department of Mainz as a student of Prof. Axel Perneczky. He passed his neurosurgical national board examination in 2003 and became associate professor. From 2005 to 2008 he was Professor and Vice-Chairman of the Neurosurgical Department of the Johannes-Gutenberg-University in Mainz. In 2008 he moved to the famous University Hospital Zurich, Switzerland, gaining additional experience in skull base and vascular neurosurgery Chairman: Prof. Helmut Bertalanffy. Recently, he is head of the Centre for Endoscopic and Minimally Invasive Neurosurgery at the Hirslanden Private Hospital in Zurich.

Professor Reisch is author and co-author of numerous scientific publications in the field of endoscopic and minimally invasive neurosurgery, including the comprehensive book on „Keyhole Approaches in Neurosurgery“, published in 2008 by Springer Publishing Company. Currently, he is tutor of the national course „Cranial Neuroendoscopy“ of the German Society of Neurosurgery (DGNC). In cooperation with Professor Nikolai Hopf he is course director of the international courses of the Aesculap Academy on „Basic, Advanced and Applied“ neuroendoscopy, including live-surgery events. Professor Reisch is a frequently invited speaker in international endoscopic courses and meetings. He is a member of the editorial boards of the journals „Minimally Invasive Neurosurgery“ and „Interventional Medicine and Applied Science“.

# GUIDELINE FREE PAPER & POSTER

## ABSTRACT

Only electronically submitted abstracts will be considered. Abstract must be submitted through [pitperspebsi2011@pharma-pro.com](mailto:pitperspebsi2011@pharma-pro.com).

Format the text in accordance with below instruction:

1. Abstract must be typed single spacing, font in 10-point only and justified at the left margin only. Do not leave blank lines between paragraphs. Do not indent.
2. Abstract title should appear in bold. Do not indent. Title should be concise and indicate the content the content of the abstract.
3. Use first initial followed by last name. omit degrees. For paper submissions, place an asterisk (\*) after the name of the author presenting the aper. On a separate line, type as succinctly as possible the names of institutions and countries.
4. Leave one blank line between the title/author block and the abstract text. The abstract text. The abstract text should include background, methods, result and conclusion.
5. Each abstract may contain up to max 500 characters, including title, authors name, affiliation and the abstract text (spaces are not counted).
6. Use italics only when appropriate (e.g., for names of genus and species). Simple atable and graphs (neat and in black ink) may be included.
7. Resubmission of a corrected or change abstract will not be accepted.
8. Deadline for abstract will not be exceeded of 11 July 2011.
9. Each abstract must be submitted in electronic form as MS WORD for window (2003 or 2007, or any previous version).

## FREE PAPER and POSTER

1. For free papers presentation, OC will provide 7 minutes presentation and 3 minutes discussion.
2. Deadline for abstract submission will not exceed of 11 July 2011.
3. The organizing Committee will send its confirmation letter for each of free paper and poster accepted.
4. A preference for oral presentation can be indicated although the scientific committee will make the final decision as to how the abstracts will presented.
5. Each poster board measures 120 cm height and 90 cm width.
6. It must fit within frame and easily readable from a distance of one meter or more. It should include brief written selections, methods, result and conclusion of presented study.
7. Abstract must be accompanied by payment of registration fees. If the abstract is sub sequently not accepted for presentation, the registration fee will be refunded to the author.

### Tangkuban Prahú

Tangkuban Prahú is an active volcano 20 km north of Bandung on 2084m altitude and the temperature in the day to about 17C. The region is renowned as a center of vegetables, flowers and tea plantation. On the top you will find a large crater Kawah Upas about 1 km diameter crater and several scattered on the flanks orientales. Tangkuban Prahú a volcano is a kind startovolcanique. Tangkuban Prahú is linked to the legend of a young man and his mother, Dayang Sangkuriang Sumbi.



### Kawah Ciwedey

Kawah Ciwedey is an active volcano, south of the town about 40km from the city. Leaving the city Spend beautiful terraced rice fields, and after growing strawberries and forest with various plant. Kawah Ciwedey is a large crater, although filled with water from rain in white. That's why we apellons the Kawah Putih or White crater.
